HVE TIP SOLUTIONS FOR DENTAL HYGIENISTS - 3 options

OPTION #1. Widemouth HVE Tip Insert inserted into a 6" HVE tip that has been cut in half. Use with a short On/Off HVE Valve opposed to standard long valves.

www.amerdental.com Short metal lever style high volume evacuator with variable on/off vacuum control and 360°swivel base connector. Autoclavable aluminum valve is easily disassembled for cleaning, but should not be cleaned by sonic methods. (Product # 0303)

For optimal evacuation, use the Blueboa saliva ejector hose, and hygoformic saliva ejector tip placed on one side of the mouth in conjunction with use of Widemouth HVE tip insert. During use, follow the HVE tip it as close to the Air Polishing tip as possible to capture aerosols.

OPTION #2. Use shorter (3.75") Young Vent-O-Vac Vented HVE tips available from Young Dental without the widemouth tip insert since when inserted into this tip, it covers the vents defeating its purpose.

NOTE: As described in Option #1, Insert the Vent-O-Vac tip onto the short On/Off HVE Valve, and use in conjunction with the Blueboa solutions.

OPTION #3. Use the Isovac isolation/HVE system from Isolite Systems <u>www.isolitesystems.com</u>. No need to use Blue Boa saliva ejector solutions with this system.
